# Chancellor's £269 Million Budget Stimulant For British Economy

LONDON Tax concessions amounting to £296 million to stimulate the British economy were announced to a packed House of Commons yesterday when the Chancellor of the Exchequer, Mr. Reginald Maudling presented his first Budgets.

The Chancellor said: "The theme of this Budget is expansion, expansion without inflation, expansion that can be sustained."

"If we are to play our full part in this dangerous world, if we are to build for our own people the standard of life they desire, if we are to increase our aid to the peoples of Africa and Asia who still count in shillings what we count in pounds, then we must have more rapid and more steady economic expansion."

The purpose of the Budget could also be clearly stated. It was to do the Government's part in achieving the rate of economic growth broadly

described as the four per cent target, which had already been accepted in the National Economic Development Council.

The Chancellor said that Britain's total revenue last year was £6,797 million which was about £4 million below the estimate. Expenditure "above the line" came out at £6,441 million £76 million above the budget estimate.

"The whole of this increase was in the field of supply expenditure. The result, 'above the line' was a surplus of £253 million, which is £80 million less than the Budget estimate, said the Chancellor.

Among the charges which the Chancellor announced were: INCOME TAX allowance will be raised by £60 to £200 for single people, and by £80 £320 for married people. Schedule 'A' tax on owned and leased residential property will be abolished.

The £1 excise duty on television licences will be abolished but this will not affect the viewer. Of the same £4 paid for a licence £1 will now go to the British Broadcasting Corporation to help finance its expanding activities. ESTATE DUTY exemption, will be raised to £5,000 from £4,000.

Child allowance will not be lost where the child's income exceeds it but will be reduced pound by pound by the excess of income over the limit.

## Other London Sister Tutor For Lagos

LONDON—The Matron of St. George's Hospital, London, Miss M. B. Powell, who recently returned from a visit to hospitals in Nigeria, said at the weekend that she hoped a Sister Tutor from St. George's would be sent to help in the Lagos School of Nursing for about a year fairly soon.

I can promise that there will be no shortage of volunteers from the Sisters at St. George's Hospital at the opportunity to work in Nigeria, she added.

St. George's Hospital already has a link with the School of Nursing, for the Principal Tutor, Miss E. Tattersall, was formerly a tutor at the London Hospital.

Miss Powell who is also President of the British Association of Hospital Matrons, praised the way in which health problems were being tackled in Nigeria. The problems are enormous, but they are being faced with great vigour and determination, she said.

I was particularly pleased by the high standard of Nigerian girls being recruited to the nursing profession in Lagos by Miss Tattersall and her staff. The University Teaching Hospital, under its Matron, Miss Morrison, is doing a magnificent job.

## U.S. CITIZENSHIP FOR CHURCHILL

WASHINGTON — Sir Winston Churchill will become an honorary United States citizen at a ceremony to be held in the White House rose garden next Tuesday and televised "live" to Britain by the relay communications satellite.



With Senate approval of it, Congress yesterday completed action on a Bill which said citizenship should be conferred "in recognition of one of America's greatest friends and in many contributions made by Sir Winston Churchill to the free world."

President Kennedy will sign the bill in the rose garden of the White House next Tuesday watched by millions of Americans and Britons who will see the ceremony on nationwide and transatlantic television hook-ups.

## Queen Invites Presidents of India and Pakistan to Britain

LONDON — An official announcement from Buckingham Palace recently said: "The President of Pakistan, Field Marshal Muhammad Ayub Khan, and the President of India, Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan, have accepted invitations from the Queen to visit Britain this year."

President Radhakrishnan, who will stay for about 12 days, will arrive in London on 12th June. President Ayub's visit will take place towards the end of October. The date of his arrival will be announced later.
