## AMERICAN EXPERT TO IMPROVE NIGERIAN GUINEA CORN

At the request of the Nigerian Government, Dr. J. O. Webster of the American Corn Corporation Administration is visiting Nigeria to assist in the development of an improved stock of guinea corn in this country by crossing American strains with Nigerian varieties.

Dr. and Mrs. Webster and their 4-year old son, who visited the American Consulate General in London last week-end, they flew down from Ibadan where Dr. Webster has been conferring with Agricultural Officers and delivering a series of special lectures at the University College.

Dr. Webster's plan breeding specialist hopes to produce in Nigeria a guinea corn variety improved along lines most desired by Nigerians and yet maintaining the qualities essential to the eating habits of the people.

Since his arrival in April with 12 varieties of American sorghum, the United States counterpart of guinea corn, Dr. Webster has conducted special research at the Agricultural Station in Samara. He brought with him, in addition to the 170 varieties, the Uniform Landrace Nursery of 35 entries, one of the most recent sorghum developments in North America.

## RELAXATION OF CURRENCY RESTRICTIONS TO TRAVELLERS

Two notices have recently appeared in the Nigerian Gazette announcing concessions made by the Bank of Nigeria to travellers. The first, concerning tourist travel and the concession made allows the accumulation and use in the current year of the unused portion of the Tourist Travel Allowance for the previous two years together with an allowance for the current year.

Thus a traveller from Nigeria would in the travel year commencing 1st May 1951, be able to draw as a maximum £100 plus £100 pins £50—£250 for adults and £70 plus £70 plus £70—£175 for children. This concession was due to the fact that the allowance had been drawn for the travel years ending 30th April, 1950 and 1951. This concession will not be made available to Nigerian residents by Banks in the United Kingdom and travellers wishing to take advantage of it are advised to make the necessary arrangements with a Bank in Nigeria before their departure.

The other concession announced raises the amount of sterling notes which a traveller may bring into Nigeria and the amount of sterling or West African Currency Bank Notes which a traveller may take out of Nigeria when proceeding to destinations outside the British West African territories, from £5 to £10.
