Public notice

As from 1st April, 1951, private practice in Government and Native Administrations or Hospitals, Dispensaries and Clinics is prohibited. To meet this McNeil's Practice was in Government employment may now accept fees from patients for medical services in Government and Native Administration institutions.

Any hospital fees charged after April 1st are charged by Government and may be paid into Government Revenue and receipt obtained.

Special collecting Officers called Almoners will be posted in these institutions for the purpose of collecting fees where no fee is due for the running of hospitals. No money should be paid to any person other than the official Almoner and a receipt must be obtained.

In Native Administration dispensaries, all fees for injections and all other treatment must be paid to the Native Administrator or Treasurer and no Official receipt obtained.

Yellow Fever and Small Pox Vaccinations and other Inoculations for Persons intending to Travel by Air

Intending passengers to air lines, agents or carriers outside West Africa must carry valid International Certificates of Vaccination against Yellow Fever and Smallpox.

YELLOW FEVER

In the case of inoculation against Yellow Fever for the FIRST TIME, the passenger may not leave Nigeria until 10 DAYS have elapsed since the date of inoculation. Passengers being re-inoculated may leave Nigeria immediately thereafter, PROVIDED THAT evidence of an inoculation, given not more than FIVE YEARS previously, is produced to the Yellow Fever Inoculating Officer. A D.D.T. test certificate on the new certificate shall be a valid re-inoculation.

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT

As the stocks of Nigeria's Yellow Fever Vaccine have become dangerously low and as new stocks are not expected for one considerable time it has been found necessary to RESTRICT THE GIVING OF YELLOW FEVER INOCULATIONS.

As from 1st January, 1951, Yellow Fever inoculations will be given only to persons who might require them for the purpose of air travel. Persons generally travelling by sea are strongly advised to obtain their inoculations or re-inoculations while overseas, before returning to Nigeria.

Yellow Fever inoculation of persons in the Lagos area will be given only in the PATHOLOGY DEPT., BROAD STREET, LAGOS, EACH S. FRIDAY MORNING AT 09.00 hours. All those persons will be inoculated who have, by letter or telephone, arranged for their inoculations with the Pathologists, Lagos, 178, Lagos 322, at least 24 hours before the time of inoculation.

SMALFOX

Vaccination against smallpox should be performed at least two weeks prior to departure as the second dose of the inter-vaccinal test will require that the vaccination site should be reopened by the Vaccinating Officer on the 5th-7th day after inoculation. The certificate is not valid for more than three years from the date of issue.

In the case of re-vaccination, the passengers should report to the Vaccinating Officer on the 2nd day after vaccination.

Intervaccinal tests in the Lagos area are performed at the HEALTH OFFICE, BROAD STREET, LAGOS, between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 12 noon daily, from Monday and at the PORT HEALTH OFFICE, Lagos, between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 12 noon daily except Sunday.

LEPROSY INCUBATIONS

Inoculations against Leprosy (Tuberculosis and Plague) may be obtained by appointment to the Pathologist or Pathology Department, Lagos (178, Lagos 322) or by application to any Doctor, Medical Officer, etc.

Two World Famed Athletes Arrived Lagos

The international athletes alighted at Lagos Airport on Thursday, April 5, 1951. They are the world-famed West Indians, A. S. WIKE and E. MANDAWA. Both of them are well-built, cheerful and apparently in good health. They said they were pleased to come out to West Africa, the homeland of their ancestors. Athlete's activities have taken them all over the world, Bailey said. "The present tour is the beginning of my tour around the continent of Africa," he said, "and I would be pleased to come to Nigeria and see if we can render some service to the people here, if no local teams were required, and if good teams were good."

Wikey was born in Jamaica.

He is at present a medical student in St Bartholomew's Hospital, London, and hopes to return to his homeland as a doctor on qualifying. He is 6 ft. 5 ins. tall, 182 lbs. in weight and 31 years old. He says his athletic career began at 15 and since then he has hardly been a year in which he did not take part in one competition or another. He is the British champion in the 400 and 880 yards races. At the last Olympic Games he came first in the 880 yards and second in the 400 yards.

Bailey is particularly good as a sprinter. He does the 100 and 22 yards and holds the championship in both events. Born in Trinidad thirty years ago, Bailey is married and has two children. Like Wikey, he is a sportsman, hardworking and cheerful. At present he is a business manager, having started a firm in England.

The two athletes seemed especially happy to meet Mr. Bunting again. Mr. Bunting was the coach of West and has been in close touch with the team since 1949. They were pleased to hear that a Nigerian school had been founded in the High Ivory - a little shore away from the city and wife.

It is on the invitation of Nigeria Amateur Athletic Association that Wikey and Bailey have flown to West Africa. Mr. J. R. Bunting, Chairman of the N.A.A.A., Mr. Bunting and other officers of the Association were present at the Airport.
