General MacArthur is dismissed Prevention Of Colour Discrimination

President Truman has relieved General MacArthur of all his Command in the Far East. He is succeeded by Lt General Ridgway, Commander of the 8th Army.

Last month a Bill to prevent co-ordination of white employment discrimination in employment practices with recourse to the law courts was introduced in the House of Representatives.

The President said that military commanders are to be governed by the policies and orders of the government, particularly at times of crisis.

An addition to the staff of the Public Relations Department and to the ranks of journalists in Nigeria is Major M. N. Heeney, Assistant Public Relations Officer (Marketing), who recently arrived in Nigeria to head the Publicity Section of the department.

For Major Heeney was with the Nigeria Regiment during the last war and went to Burma with the 42nd West Africa Division, later becoming Deputy Director of Welfare Services for West Africa Command.

Last year he toured the four West Africa Colonies as a travelling correspondent. One of the best known contributors to Colonial Journals, he is also a well-known broadcaster. During last year he did twenty-two broadcasts from the B. C. to West and East Africa, including and interesting series on African politics, a series sketching the early history West Africa.
