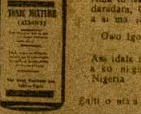

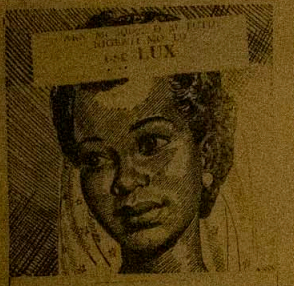

Trade Unionist & Labour Commissioner To Visit USA

Mr. A. A. Adia-Moses, Secretary of the Amalgamated Union of Clerical and Allied Workers of Nigeria, and Mr. A. H. Cousins, Commissioner of Labour Affairs, have been invited to visit the United States during 1964 under the Foreign Leader Program of the United States Government.

They become the first residents of Nigeria to be awarded Foreign Leader grants under the

Program of the Smith-Mundt Act, the American Consulate General at New York City. Mr. Adia-Moses and Mr. Cousins are to be selected by the U.S. Department of State from a list of applicants whose requests for grants were submitted to the Department through the American Consulate General in Lagos.

The grants provide transportation from Nigeria to Washington and return, necessary travel within the United States, and 120 days from the date of departure in America. The grants will also cover and survey various aspects of organized labour practices and procedures in leading industrial and growth centers.

A native of Lagos, Mr. Adia-Moses is former Secretary of the Nigerian Trades Union Congress and is now a member of the Lagos Executive Development Board, the Nigerian Corporation, and a prominent on trade unionism for the Lagos "Daily Times". He was educated at St. Gregory's and St. Peter's Schools, Olatunji, Kofor, Kwana Owing, Olatunji and the British Trade Union College, London.

Born in Portsmouth, Hants, County, England, Cousins has served as Inspector of Factories in the British Ministry of Labour and National Service. He is a graduate of the University College, London, and has done special post-graduate studies in high-frequency electrical engineering.

Man Kills Six People & Wife

Three people died in the spot and three others died in hospital as a result of a shooting incident on seven individuals by Timothy Agueum at Enugu on the 15th of April. The victim was a small girl, 11 years old, who was shot in the hospital and she died on her wounds.

Timothy Agueum, a native of Mbaiti in Owerri Province, is a shop-for-man in the employ of the Nigerian Coal Corporation at Enugu. He had suspected his wife of being unfaithful, but the matter was mutually settled between him and his wife by a delegation from their home-people.

Colonial Doctor's Shortage

AFRICAN HOSPITALS CLOSED

The shortage of recruits to the British African medical services has been discussed in Parliament this week.

Mr. J. Johnson, M.P., asked the Secretary of State for the Colonies how many hospitals and dispensaries have been closed down in Kenya and Sierra Leone through short age of doctors, what steps were being taken to recruit African doctors in Great Britain for the Colonial Medical Service, and how many scholarships for medical training had been awarded during the last three years by the Government of Kenya and Sierra Leone.

Mr. J. Griffith M.P. said that no hospitals or dispensaries had been closed in Kenya, but he recalled that in February 1951 staff shortages made it necessary temporarily to close two hospitals in Sierra Leone. Posts in the Colonial Medical Service were widely advertised and African medical students were encouraged to apply for them.

During the last three years the Kenya Government had awarded seventeen scholarships for medical training, and had also paid £24,000 to Makerere College for the training of African Medical Officers. The Sierra Leone Government had made seven awards and two awards had been made to Sierra Leonean students from the central institution of colonial development and Welfare Dept.

Questions About Africa's Administrators

The Governors of Uganda and Kenya have been asked by the Secretary of State for the Colonies to report on the training of Africans in local Government.
