

TRAINING COURSE AT THE NIGERIAN COLLEGE OF ARTS, SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, IBADAN.

Applications are invited from persons born in the Western Region for places on a training course in local government, to be held at the Ibadan branch of the Nigeria College of Arts, Science and Technology. The course will begin in October, 1956, and will last for approximately eight months.




