

Lagos Town Council Nightsoil Conservancy Service

1. For some time now there have been widespread complaints about the Council's Nightsoil Conservancy Service, which is being done by contract as far back as 1954. Pails in the premises serviced by the Council are supposed to be cleared every night. The Council's Contractors, however, fail to clear these pails every night. In fact there are premises where the pails are not cleared for many days together. This is a great inconvenience to the occupiers of such premises and a danger to public health.

2. Side by side with the Council's service exists a large practice in conservancy by a number of private bodies and individuals of varying efficiency. Investigation has revealed that the men employed by the Council's Contractors indulge in private practice to an extent that has seriously undermined the efficiency of the Council's service and has been the cause of several people leaving that service to go to these unauthorised private Nightsoilmen.

3. Under the Lagos Local Government Law of 1953, the Lagos Town Council is responsible for the clearing and disposal of nightsoil from all premises in the Municipality that have no septic tank installation. Council has therefore approved the introduction by October 1st 1957, of a new scheme by which all premises in the Town shall be serviced by the Council's Contractors. To start with, this scheme will be limited to all premises in Lagos Island and Ikoyi as well as to those premises already being serviced on the Mainland by the Council. It is proposed that the service will be extended to the remaining premises in the Municipality at no distant date,

4. The new scheme will be much bigger than the one Council now operates. But a survey of all premises in the Municipality has been made by the Town Engineer and details of the extra staff, transport, and cost to cope with the expanded services have been carefully worked out.

5. The existing scheme covers approximately 2,540 pails and costs Council 21/5d per pail per month of daily service, while the Council has hitherto charged only 7/6d per pail: This means that the service has hitherto been subsidised from the rates to the tune of approximately 14/- per pail. The new scheme to cover the whole Municipality will involve the servicing of about 16,500 pails. Council will charge 17/6d per pail per month of daily service. This is the amount below which Council cannot go without having to raise the rates.

6. The Council in assuming the responsibility that it already by its law holds that the public will place public health and efficiency of the service above sentiments and give it the understanding and co-operation it needs to make the new scheme a success.

Western Region Government Scholarships

The Western Regional Government will be awarding a further 100 scholarships this year to suitable qualified candidates of Western Region origin. The scholarships will be tenable at institutions in Nigeria commencing from the academic year 1957-58 and will generally be tenable at Colleges and Institutions abroad commencing from the academic year 1958-59. Students already studying at institutions abroad however, may, depending upon the recommendations of the Scholarship Board, have their awards made tenable from an earlier date.

2. The Courses for which awards will be made will include Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary, Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy, Mental Nursing, Hospital Administration, General degree courses in Arts, Maths & Science, Architecture, Geology, Education, Hides & Skins, Survey and Articles of Clerkship with Firms of Solicitors for training as Solicitors.

3. The awards for survey course will be offered only to members of the Survey Department of the Western Region and separate instructions in regard to these awards will be circulated departmentally.

4. Suitable candidates already serving in the Agriculture, Forest and Veterinary Departments will also be considered for awards provided they hold Grade II Cambridge or West African School Certificates with credit in at least one science subject. All other candidates should ensure that their academic qualifications are adequate for direct entry to suitable institutions for degree courses either at the University College, Ibadan or Overseas, as no scholarships will be offered for pre-University training except to those candidates already serving in the Departments named above.

5. Only persons of Western origin will be eligible for awards.

6. Applications for scholarships may be made by candidates of either sex, preference normally being given to those candidates under thirty years of age.

7. The minimum qualification required from any applicant is grade II Cambridge School Certificate with exemption from London Matriculation or Grade II West African School Certificate. Applicants holding only a Grade III Cambridge School Certificate or who have obtained exemption from London Matriculation as the basis of such a certificate will not be considered for an award.

8. In the case of candidates resident in Nigeria, scholarships will not be made tenable abroad where courses are available in this country.

9. Candidates, wishing to proceed to University College Ibadan or to the Nigeria College of Arts, Science and Technology, to undertake courses of study which are available there must apply direct to the College Authorities to sit for examinations in accordance with the procedure prescribed and will not be eligible for awards unless they have been accepted for entry by the College Authorities.

10. Candidates applying for courses of study at institutions outside Nigeria should ensure that their academic qualifications are sufficient to enable them to be placed in suitable institutions to undertake degree courses as soon as selected, as scholarships abroad will not be offered for General Certificate of Education (Advanced Level) Courses or equivalent qualifications.

11. Applications from persons holding degrees, wishing to be trained as Solicitors will also be considered. The period of training for persons holding a degree is three years and five years for those without degrees.

12. All applications for scholarships must be completed in duplicate on the prescribed forms which may be obtained from All provincial Education Offices in the Western Region. The Secretary to the Scholarship Board, Ministry of Education, (Students Division), Ibadan;

13. Application forms must be completed in duplicates and returned direct to the Secretary to the Scholarship Board, Ministry of Education, (Student Division), Western Region, Ibadan, through Heads of Department in the case of Government employees, and

through Principals of Schools or Colleges or through employers as appropriate in all other cases and should be received not later than 15th September, 1957.

14. Central or Regional Ministers must not be given as referees, and applicants who resort to canvassing will be disqualified.

15. Successful candidates will be required to enter into bonds to serve the Western Regional Government for period of not more than five years after the successful completion of their courses of study.
