(a) The West African School Certificate with a credit in English Language or an equivalent qualification; or

(b) The General Certificate of Education at Ordinary level with a credit in English Language or the General Certificate of Education at Higher English Language has been added on a subsequent occasion at an equivalent qualification.

Secondary Modern School Leavers Competitive Examination FOR ENTRY TO THE PUBLIC SERVICE OF THE WESTERN REGION, 1958.

This examination, which is open to pupils of Secondary Modern Schools in the final terms of their three-year course will be held on Friday, the 21st of November, 1958.

Applications to sit the examination should be handed with a fee of 5/- to Headmasters.

The examination will be held in each Secondary Modern School in which there are candidates and will consist of two papers each of one and half hours duration:-

(i) 9-11.30 a.m. English, at a level higher than that of Secondary Modern School Leaving Certificate; and

(ii) 11 a.m.-12.30 p.m. General a paper designed to assess the candidate's general knowledge and his initiative and resourcefulness.

Only the worked papers of candidates who have been successful in the Secondary Modern School Leaving Certificate Examination will be considered. No refund of fees will be made to those who fail the School Leaving Certificate Examination.

Successful candidates will be eligible for entry into the Regional Public Service in the Clerical Assistant or equivalent grade at the first point of Scale P, 1 (£14-£156 per annum).
