Bad drivers get warning

It May Be Time For New Road Penalties Safety Chiefs Told

(By Our London Correspondent)

A new framework of penalties to punish "persistently bad and irresponsible road behaviour" was suggested yesterday by Lord Chesham, Parliamentary Secretary to the Transport Ministry.

He told 1,000 delegates to a National Road Safety Congress at Southport, Lancashire: "Road casualties are a many-headed monster. Progress in one direction is offset by a retreat elsewhere".

Lord Chesham was commenting on the big increase in the number of people killed and injured on the roads during the first six months of this year, compared with the same period last year.

He said that there had been 6.3 per cent more deaths and a 4.6 per cent increase in serious injury accidents.

"Quit rightly," he said, "the public need for Government initiative to combat this situation is urgent.

"There are some things which only the Government has the power and resources to undertake.

"Perhaps one of the most controversial aspects of road safety to-day is how to treat the drunken driver. There have been columns of criticism and comment as to his degree of blame and, indeed, on what to do with him".

Blood Check

LORD Chesham said: "Should the law be re-defined to make it easier for the police to bring proceedings in cases where they are completely satisfied that a driver is unfit to drive through drink or drugs, although he is not incapable drunk in the ordinary sense of the phrase?"

"Should courts have regard to a chemical analysis of the quantity of alcohol in the blood of a driver?"

He added: "Has not the time also come when persistently bad road behaviour must be recognised and dealt with by an entirely new framework of penalties for road traffic offences?"

Road deaths in 1960 rose by seven per cent over 1959. They totalled 6,970, says the annual report on accidents issued by the Transport Ministry and Scottish Home Department Serious injuries rose by five per cent to 84,443.

Other points in the report: There were 22 killed and 161 badly hurt on the M1 during its first year of operation.

The Digest is directed particularly at people travelling for pleasure and is concisely and informatively written, with a light touch which make it entertaining reading as well.

British Professor To Teach At Ife University

SCOTLAND - When Dr. Robert H. Cairns, head of the Department of English at Queen's College, Dundee (St. Andrews University) takes up his new appointment to the Chair of English at the University of Ife, on 1st September,

it will fulfil an ambition he has long cherished.

"I have been feeling for some time that I would like to work in Africa and I am particularly looking forward to taking a position in a new university in a new country," he told our correspondent yesterday.

"The job presents many interesting and exciting possibilities, while the prospect of living in the ancient spiritual capital of the Yoruba people - is very stimulating. I am hoping to have time to delve into its archeology, and I want to see some of the famous shrines and terraces," Dr. Cairns added.

During his five years at Dundee and in the two previous years at Bedford College, London University, Dr. Cairns has met many Nigerian students for whom he has a high regard.
