

A great deal of this building has proceeded on land where streets, drainage, sanitation and water-supply are not available.

The living conditions of people housed under these conditions can rapidly become insanitary and unsatisfactory and devoid of any private or public welfare access.

Urban development in large towns requires a careful design and provision of storm water drainage and road access otherwise the areas are becomes liable to vehicles and subject to flooding in the rainy season.

Street and drainage work is generally undertaken by the public authority, the responsibility of the Lagos Town Council and it is carried throughout the town, and partly by local governments. The town council of Lagos Town Council is carrying out a 5-year programme, but only about ten thousand houses have been completed.

The rate of expansion of making up roads and providing drainage is therefore limited, and building development must be controlled within this limitation.



### THE FUTURE

### THE DREDGER AT WORK IN FIVE COWRIE CREEK

The four villages — Ijukuri, Emeni and Apam Elegba which are affected by the South-West Tropical Drainage Development Scheme have been completely cleared. Bay clearance has also been finished and reclamation by sand pumping has started. A total population of 20,172 (including children) were evicted and £1.6m Compensation amounting to over £15,000 was paid to 10 tenents as well as landlords.

Demolition work are expected to start sometime in August. Meanwhile the sand-pumping continues from a dredger which is moored in Five Cowrie Creek.
