## Yellow Fever and Small Pox Vaccinations and other Inoculations for Persons Intending to Travel by Air

Intending passengers by air from Nigeria to destinations outside West Africa must carry valid International Certificate of Vaccination against Yellow Fever and Smallpox.

### YELLOW FEVER

In the case of international air travel Yellow Fever for the FIRST TIME, the minimum age is not less than 9 months...

### IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT

As the onset of Nigeria Yellow Fever Vaccine has become dangerously low and as new stocks are not expected for some considerable time, it has been advised previously to RESTRICT THE GIVING OF YELLOW FEVER INOCULATIONS.

As from 1st January, 1951, Yellow Fever inoculations will be given only to persons who urgently require them for the purpose of air travel.

Yellow Fever inoculations of persons in the Lagos area will be given only to the PATHOLOGY DEPT., BRIDGE STREET, LAGOS, each SATURDAY MORNING AT 9.00 hours.

### SMALLPOX

Vaccination against smallpox should be performed at least five weeks prior to departure, as the second part of the International Certificate requires that the vaccination should be repeated by the Vaccinating Officer on the fifth day after vaccination.

Vaccinations in the Lagos area are performed at the HEALTH OFFICIAL, BRIDGE STREET, LAGOS, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 11.30 a.m. daily, except Sunday and on the PORT HEALTH OFFICE, Lagos, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 11 a.m. daily except Sunday.

### OTHER INOCULATIONS

Intoculations against Cholera, Typhoid and Plague may be obtained by request from the Pathologist (C. Pathology Department, Lagos (Tel. Lagos 312)) or by application to any Junior Medical Officer.
