Ruby Found Guilty And Sentenced To Death

DALLAS—Jack Ruby has been found guilty and sentenced to death for the murder of Lee Harvey Oswald, accused assassin of President Kennedy.

The jury of eight-men and four women returned the verdict east Saturday afternoon:

Texas Judge Joe B. Brown, who had heard the case read the verdict: We, the Jury, find the defendant guilty of murder with malice and assess his punishment at death. It was the maximum penalty.

The 52-year-old Dallas night club operator fired a single fatal shot into Mr. Oswald's body in the Dallas City jail as the manacled prisoner was being transferred to the county jail. The crime occurred on November 24 two days after the assassination of President Kennedy.

His Chief defense counsel Mr. Melvin Belli announced that he would appeal against the verdict.

During the four week trial the testimony revolved around the question of Mr. Ruby's legal sanity at the time of the crime. The State charged that the defendant did unlawfully, voluntarily and with malice aforethought kill the accused assassin.

Defense lawyers sought a verdict of not guilty on the ground that he was insane at the time of the crime.

The prosecution and defense placed 66 witnesses on the stand many of them qualified as experts in the field of psychology or neurology.

World Bank Extends Major Loan To Nigeria

Washington—The World Bank has extended a \$30 million loan to Nigeria to help extend the nation's electrical power network.

The loan the largest the World Bank has made to Nigeria was signed on Thursday in Washington by Mallam Ibrahim Usman Chairman of the Electricity Corporation of Nigeria and J. Burkhardt Knapp, Vice President of the World Bank.

The project is part of a large expansion program being carried out to provide adequate power supplies to meet Nigeria's rapidly growing manufacturing and family consumer needs.

In meeting with newsmen following the signing ceremony at the World Bank Headquarters, Mallam Usman said the sale of electricity in Nigeria has been expanding for the

past five years at an annual average rate of 24 percent.

He said Nigeria is interested in recruiting qualified American mechanical and electrical engineers to help in the nation's electrical expansion program.

An announcement on the loan issued by the World Bank explained that some American, British and German banks participated in the loan,

The Legend Of Timbuktoo

The celebrated city of Timbuktoo in the Mali Republic has long been associated with remoteness and inaccessibility. Indeed, some people even think that it is a mythical city that does not exist.

But Timbuktoo is far from mythical and not particularly isolated, as listeners to the BBC programme LONDON FANFARE heard recently when Oumar Thiam of Mali spoke about this famous place:

"Set on the fringe of the Sahara Desert, Timbuktoo city has been legend for nearly two centuries," he said. "It was said to be the city of gold and has been an important commercial and intellectual centre, with its ancient Islamic university." Last century and particularly during the 1830's, so many European explorers were killed or forbidden to enter the mysterious city by the Hoggar Tuaregs or by the Moors, that the Timbuktoo legend was begun. To go to Timbuktoo meant willingness to suffer thirst, hunger and discomfort."

Among these explorers were the American adventures John Ledyard, who succumbed to malaria in his attempts to reach the city; the young Scotsman Mungo Park and many others who were drowned while trying to trace the sources of the River Niger. But the first white Christian who went to Timbuktoo and returned was the French explorer René Caillé, in 1830.

"These days," said Oumar Thiam, Timbuktoo has become open to anyone and nowadays thousands of tourists come to enjoy the fabulous sight of its desert landscape, where white mosques contrast with the adventurous and exotic blue men on their camels.

Believe me, Timbuktoo is a real paradise, and very much a reality.
