MR. CHARLES MATTHEW
APPOINTED CHIEF
JUSTICE, MALAYA.

It is announced by the Secretary of State for the Colonies that the King has pleased to approve the appointment of Mr. CHARLES MATTHEW, C.M.G., as Chief Justice, Federation of Malaya, in succession to Sir Stafford Foster Sutton, C.M.J., Q.B.E., who has been appointed President of the West African Court of Appeal.

Mr. Matthew, who was born in London in 1903, was educated at Downside School and Trinity College, Oxford. He was called to the Bar in 1927 and entered the Colonial Service in 1929 as an Administrative Officer in Nigeria. In 1936 he was transferred to the Colonial Legal Service as a magistrate in Uganda and appointed Crown Counsel in 1936. In 1933, he was appointed Judicial Advisor, Buganda.

From 1932 to 1936 he was assigned to Ethiopia as an Advisor to the Ethiopian Government. In 1944 he was appointed Attorney General, Nyassaland, and in 1947, was transferred to his present post of Attorney General Tanganyika.
