NIGERIAN PORTS AUTHORITY

TENDERS FOR SUPPLY OF LORRY TRANSPORT

Tenders are invited from lorry transport contractors normally operating in Port Harcourt for carrying out the following works for the period of one year:-

- (a) conveying produce on a tonnage basis by suitable flat lorries from Arcon Sheds and Warehouses in Port Harcourt Quay to ships' side within the area of the Quay or from ships' side to the Arcon Sheds and Warehouses within the same area;
 - (b) the supply of suitable vehicles up to and including 10 tons capacity on a time basis for work either within or outside the quay area other than for the purpose covered in (a) above.
2. Requisitions for lorries will depend on the needs of the Dock Superintendent which will fluctuate considerably from day-to-day but contractors must be able to meet requirements at all times.
3. No labour will be required of the contractor to load or off-load produce and this fact must be borne in mind when quoting rates.
4. Contractors interested should apply to the undersigned or to the Port Manager, Nigerian Ports Authority, Port Harcourt, for the Form of Tender including the draft of the Agreement which will be entered into.
5. A deposit of £10 is required to be made by each contractor wishing to tender before the Form of Tender can be issued. Such deposit should be made to the Authority's Cashier either at Apapa Quays, Lagos, or at Port Harcourt Quay, Port Harcourt and the receipt presented to either the undersigned or to the Port Manager, Port Harcourt, to enable the Form of Tender to be issued. Deposits are returnable only on receipt of a bona fide tender.
6. All tenders, irrespective of where the form has been obtained must be enclosed in sealed envelopes, marked "CONFIDENTIAL-TENDER FOR LORRY TRANSPORT, PORT HARCOURT" and must be submitted to the Secretary to the Authority, 216, Broad Street, Lagos, to reach him not later than 4 p.m. on 31st day of January 1963.
