### Three Nigerians Win American Grants

The American Consulate General announced that three Nigerians, graduates of American colleges, have been awarded United States Government Grants through the Department of State's student exchange programme to assist them in study during 1951-52 toward graduate degrees in leading American universities.

The grants, administered by the Department of State in cooperation with the Institute of International Education, have been awarded to Laywola Adeyemi Adedeji, Lagos; Simon Obi Anokwe of Ukpok, Onitsha Province, and Huziada Adedunmola Oluwasanmi of Ipetu-Ipetu.

The grant to Mr Adedeji, a graduate of Southwestern College in Winfield, Kansas, covers the full cost of tuition and fees, books, maintenance, health insurance as well as return travel from New York to Nigeria. He will study toward a graduate degree in education at the University of Illinois.

A similar grant has been made to Mr Anokwe, a graduate of St. John's University in Brooklyn, New York, who will study toward an advanced degree in journalism at Columbia University. Mr Oluwasanmi, an honour graduate of Morehouse College, Atlanta, Georgia, will study toward a graduate degree in economics at Harvard University with the assistance of a grant covering costs of tuition and fees, maintenance and books.


