To-morrow's Commemoration Service

To-Day Saturday, September 29, 1951, is known in the Christian circles as the Feast of St. Michael and All Angels.

The importance of this day to Christians the world over cannot be too over-emphasised.

A year ago to-day Friday, September 29, 1950, the new service (the Chancel, the Chapel, the Vestries, the Hall etc.) of the Church, Paul's Church Broadfruit Lane, was formally opened in the presence of a very large gathering, drawn from all walks of life. His grace the Rt. Revd. L. Gordon Vicar, C.R.E., M.A., D.D., the Archbishop of West Africa, assisted them by the Venerable Dr. J. O. Luaka, M.A., D.D., Rev. J. B. Palusi, Vicar of the Church and the Archdeacon of Lagos, and the Church's Curate respectively, and an appreciable number of other Clergymen in the Lagos (Anglican) Diocese. In celebrating the first anniversary of the great event under reference, the Cleric and the Lay members of the Church will hold a Commemoration Service in the Church tomorrow, Sunday September 30.

At 9 a.m., a Thanksgiving Service will be held, when the Rev. W. B. Kaye, M.A., D.Th. Vicar, St. Peter's Church (Fiji), Lagos, will be the special preacher.

At 6 p.m., a Commemoration Service will be the order of the day the commemoration sermon being preached by the Venerable Archdeacon Dr. J. O. Luaka.

The anniversary celebration Divine Service will be brought to a close with the administration

of the Holy Communion commencing at 7 p.m., with Rev. S. O. Adegun, the Curate of the Church, as the celebrant.

May the Church's Parish-ours—one and all—be ever abundantly blessed and spiritually elevated so as to be better able to continue worshipping God in the beauty of holiness.
