LAW AND POLICE.

REX versus EMASUEL OBITOJU.

The accused aged about 21 pleaded guilty to theft of Gas Lamp value £10 from Timuba Church during the month of May, 1923.

The facts of the case are briefly —

The Sexton of Timuba Church opened the windows and doors of the Church for divine worship as usual in the month of May—He discovered after the end of the evening service that the Gas Lamp hanging in the middle of the Church had been removed. He complained to the Authorities of the Church, and the lamp was traced up to an Auctioneer's Mart, where it was taken to by the accused. The Court passed sentence of three months on the accused.

REX versus BELU ADEOSI & JEWELLIA.

For stealing Jewellery value £14-10, from a Cripple.

The accused Belu Adeosi pleaded guilty, and was sentenced to six months imprisonment, after admitting previous conviction of three months for theft at the Lagos Police Court.

The facts are shortly —

The accused was allowed to take shelter (in a rainy day) in the house of the Complainant who is a Cripple. The Jewellery was left lying on the window close to where the accused was sitting. The complainant discovered after the accused had gone that his Jewellery was not there. He had left it. He subsequently reported to the Police and the accused Belu Adeosi's house was searched, and Jewellery found.

The Court passed sentence of six months on the accused and discharged the accused Jabulali.

REX versus JAMES

For using Jaja in his Master's food the accused, a lad of about 19 was convicted before His Worship Mr. H. S. Bardsley at the Lagos Police Court.

The facts are shortly:—

The accused whose duty it was to carry meals from the Grand Hotel to his master's Quarters daily, was called upon for explanation by his master for the strange taste in the Bovril, stuffed Onions, boiled Ham, and Potatoes served by him.

He had no explanation to give, and a medical Officer was called in—on examination the food was found to contain a substance probably, a native love potion which is supposed to produce stray affection between the giver the recipient.

The Court passed sentence of three months on the accused.

SHORT STUDIES ON YORUBA WARRIORS.

OGEDE-NGBE GBOGUN-GBORO.

Chief Ogede-ngbe was born in a farm in Ifeja on or about 1834; his "bringing out ceremony" on the 9th day was performed by the Owa of Ifeja, in accordance with the Ifa Oracle consulted by the child's parents, when it was in the womb; and the oracle went on to predict the future brilliant career of the new-born babe; a cow was slaughtered in honour of the festive day; on Ogede-ngbe arriving at the age of discretion, it was not very long before he began to show his countrymen the stuff—military—of which he was made. In one of his expenditures he was made a prisoner, and brought to Ibadan, during the time Ogunmola here it was suggested that he should be sacrificed to the god Ogun; his hands were at once tied backwise, and his mouth gagged; but through the good graces of Ogunmola, his life was spared and another human victim was provided for the sacrifice; eventually, he was liberated and allowed to return to his country, on reaching home, he was at once made the leader, or captain of the war-party during the Odole war; he waged war with Ibadan for 3 years without break; after this, he went to Ipeju; here all his army repaired to him leaving their wives, children, etc., after they have been defeated by the Ibadans in the Odole war; he conquered Iseyin in a 3 years' engagement; he got back all the Ifejas formerly taken

prisoners by the belligerents and went on an expedition against Ekun, Afo, etc., and conquered them; he was called back home, when the Oyo were waging war with the Ibadans in which fight, he was engaged for 18 years. It was shortly after this, that it is said, Governor Carter went to the hinterland to settle the long standing feud existing between the different Yoruba countries. After peace was restored, Ogede-ngbe's guns and ammunitions were taken possession of, and brought down the coast by the British Government. On one occasion when he was asked why he did not like being crowned he replied that as no royal blood was flowing in his veins, such a step if undertaken by him, will amount to nothing, but sheer folly and fraud; during his military exploits, we are told that Labinjo, a contemporary of the late Chief Daniel Conrad Taiwo's *alias* Taiwo Oloso, was his principal "Secretary of State for War" as he it was, to whom orders for guns and ammunitions from Europe were generally entrusted, by the veteran chief. Chief Ogede-ngbe waged war with the different tribes of Yorubaland in war with his country, for several years. In stature, he was finely built; being short, plump and nimble; he was a veritable terror to the enemies of his native land; he departed this life at Ifeja in 1906.

THE BIRTH OF A NEW ERA.

A Public meeting in connexion with the proposed founding of THE NIGERIAN NATIONAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY was held at The Glover Memorial Hall on Thursday last at 3 p.m. under the auspices of the *Ilu* Committee.

Counsellor J. Egerton Shyngle, Barrister-at-Law, Chairman of the *Ilu* Committee presided, supported on the *dais* by the *elite* of the Community.

Amongst those that addressed the meeting, besides the Chairman, on the Aims and Objects of the proposed Party, strictly political, with particular reference to the impending Legislative Council Election, are Messrs Thomas H.
