Macaulay & Co. of Badagry, who arranged with the Monsignor Faux, the English Agent of the French Company, to permit the *Faadi* to go along side the African Oil Nuts Wharf. The party was met by the energetic Secretary of the Committee, Mr. S. Egun, Adeniji, District Officer's Chief Clerk at the landing stage. The party were lodged at the Post House where every comfort that could be desired was provided. Coffee was served and the party indulged in dancing and games until 5 a.m.

According to the Programme for Saturday the 24th at 7 a.m. the party started in procession to the premises of Messrs. African Oil Nuts where Tennis was played till 9 a.m. when the sun rays made it impossible to continue. The party retired to the Post House and a sumptuous breakfast was served.
