FACTS AND FIGURES

West Africa's First Mohammedan Barrister.

A Phase in Moslem Education.

If it were somewhere down Georgia, Texas or North
Carolina—in the lands of Stars and Stripes—the still but
unique gathering of enthusiastic people that took place in
front of No. 52, Itambose Street on the 28th of last month
could have from appearance been unambiguously taken to be
a night parade of the K.K.K.!!!

This not being the case the present gathering had behind
it a motive which must be lauded by all and sundry.

Mr. L. B. Azu-to, First President of the Abimafia Move-
ment on Nigeria and first Moslem Barrister in the whole
length of British West Africa, was called to the Bar that
particular evening and it was deemed necessary to make a
demonstration to honour the "call."

Dr. O. Sappara I.S.O. in his opening speech (on the occasion) was
painted out to which was not only because this gentleman was
called to the Bar as many worthy sons of the soil
have been called many a time before him but because
Lagos has been the first to produce a Mohammedan
Barrister in the whole of West Africa an honour—may, a
sign of progress—that will reflect not only on the Moham-
medan community but on the country as a whole. At the
end of a brief but interesting speech Dr. Sappara fired a
rocket to demonstrate his joy.

Mr. L. A. Cardoso followed this with another brief
interesting speech. He said among other things that
Azeuto is a Mohammedan because he was born to
religion and he (Mr. Cardoso) a Christian because
he was born in Christianity; so it is the fault of nature of
them to belong to different religions. We were first born, a
before we take a religion and there, is no consent why
religion should delay us from our national duties.

The two speeches were followed by loud applause and a
grand display of fireworks which lasted the best part of the
evening.

This is no doubt an interesting phase in local Mohamme-
dan education and—though Rome was not built in a day—
we earnestly look forward for the day when the Moham-
medan Community will have its own band of Lawyers,
Doctors, Civil Engineers, etc. etc. Those would be happy
days when there will be no Mohammedan Crisis at least of
the kind presently in existence—a time when an
intelligent, educated and consequently law-abiding Imam
shall have to submit to the orders of the majority, a practice
obtainable in all enlightened societies.

Readers of this paper are hinted last week of the
impending arrival of Mr. L. B. Azu-to and we sincerely
hope this energetic and painstaking gentleman will be given
a welcome which will befit his score. Let the Abimafia
Movement start making arrangements from now. Let all
educated Moslems in town watching Abimafia or not prepare
to give him the reception that he deserves. "Nay, let the
Christians, the well-meaning Christians, who believe they
were born Negroes first before they are Christians prepare
and receive this personage with as much liberality as their
brother-in-faiths can permit.

In fact, we must commend with all sincerity the spirit
which has inspired men of the positions of Dr. O. Sappara
and L. A. Cardoso to organize or take part in a demonstra-
tion such as that of the 28th of last month.

It is that celebrated poet, Rudyard Kipling, who said
East is East and West is West; and the twain shall never
meet. We hope that this, to day, cannot be applied to
Christians and Mohammedans in Lagos nor can it apply to
any "our Negro and another.
