## A BRIEF REPORT.

MEETING HELD TO EXPLAIN THE

OBJECT OF STARTING

"EKO-AKETE." BY OTITO-KORO.

A public meeting in which was explained the Object as well as the necessity of starting "Eko-Akete" was arranged by Mr. Adeoye Deniga (The Editor) and took place at Ilupesi Hall Great Bridge Street, on the 22nd June, 1922.

Mr. Herbert Macaulay, C.E., who was to have occupied the Chair that afternoon being absent, due it is said to slight indisposition, Iman Amadé was called upon to occupy the Chair. Mr. Deniga, opened the meeting at about 5 p.m. with a long explanatory as well as instructive address on the Yoruba Literature and the necessity for a Yoruba Newspaper in the local world of journalism. In the course of the address which lasted over 40 minutes, copies of every periodical published in Lagos, were held out, one after another, for exhibition among the audience.

General consultation, whispering etc. among the hearers followed the conclusion of the opening address.

The Chairman rose and gave a short speech in form of a reply to the address. He said among other things:—"What Mr. Deniga brought this afternoon is a very good scheme. Since you (i.e. Mr. Deniga) have been forming the idea, God too has been helping you. It is indeed a thing by which the whole town would be benefited. May God help you in this venture. We followed all the points raised in your address and are glad, having children in School ourselves. All those "bigmen" of the town whom you invited must have unavoidably been absent. But be assured I shall deliver message to them. You will be good enough to go on in your

good work until through the help of God you will be able to summon a larger meeting when the Country will be able to appreciate your work." This was followed by MR G. F. Onoye who said *inter alia*—"We thank the people present here this afternoon for their attendance. I have been following the speeches very closely. There are many reasons why a Yoruba newspaper is necessary particularly here in Lagos.

Many things have been going on in town with which a large section of Yoruba speaking or reading people are not acquainted. You may remember many years ago when attempt was made to gag the Press in Lagos. Petitions were sent by great men of the town, by Churches, Societies etc.

At last the Prayers of the people were granted and the existence of the Press continued. The press is a very valuable medium.

What Mr. Deniga said is all right but as a child he ought to receive your support. As you said he ought to call a bigger meeting, but that does not mean that we here this afternoon cannot think for ourselves." The meeting was closed (at about 6.30 p.m.) with a short speech by Mr. Deniga in which he said among other things:—

"I thank you all very much for your attendance I am greatly encouraged by the speeches of the Chairman. But lest you run away with a wrong idea, I must assure you that I have been managing Newspapers not to-day so there need not be any fear about political questions. Again, I am very thankful to you all." The meeting which was conducted in Yoruba throughout contained about 60 hearers and some notable people were present. Thus ended a meeting to tell the Lagos Public of the necessity to start a Yoruba Newspaper in these days. Although I have unavoidably left much to be desired (and for this I ask the excuse of my readers) yet the few words I have been able to get down speak for themselves.

"Enough" says an author "is as good as feast." Mr. Adeoye Deniga has done enough in furthering the improvement of our own literature, and in all his undertakings he should be wished every success.

#### ELETI-QFÉ AND THE MOHAMMEDANS.

To the Editor "EKO AKETE."

Sir,

I read with much disgust an unjust attack made on the Mohammedans of Lagos by one Eleti Qfē in your issue for August 5.

I am sorry for not being a good hand in Yoruba writing but believe this short letter (in English) will help to refute his misleading and nonsensical statements.

It is Shakespeare who wrote:—

"This above all,—to thine own self  
be true,  
And must follow as the night  
the days,  
Thou canst not then be false to  
any man."

I am by no means purporting to show that the Mohammedans have no blame in the crisis. On the other hand, I am trying to tell Eleti Qfē, and thereby any one who shares his opinion, that Mohammedans are not the only Section responsible. Now the question necessarily arises whether Eleti-Qfē is true to himself or whether he is not Eleti-kunkun, the opposite of what he calls himself.

"Mohammedans" says he "are hard-hearted. They brought their troubles to Eleko three years ago etc."

This is a simple passage from the Yoruba Epistle of Eleti Qfē and it is enough to show his disposition:

Can any one, sane and level headed blame the Mohammedans alone for the present confusion in the political life of the Country? Look back to the early stages of Eleko crisis. Tell me how many Mohammedans and how many Christians are in the famous "13." How many do you find in the Star Chamber? Is it a Mohammedan who made such a bad press propaganda misrepresenting the matters every now and again and adding fuel to the already burning political fire? Is it a Mohammedan who said that Eleko is a dead tree and should not be denied a decent burial? Go to the root of the Mohammedan crisis and what do you find? Christians of course! The Mohammedans, left to themselves, their affairs would not have come to a crisis.

At least, it is a gross injustice on the part of Eleti-Qfē to saddle the bulk of the Mohammedans (who are mostly illiterate and unenlightened) with the whole blame.

To settle the present crisis lies very much in the hands of you Christians—you have the papers in your hands; you have the ink, the pen; nay, you know the shortest and best roads leading to the Government House. So you stand a better chance in the whole confusion.

Again, I ask, is Eleti Qfē true to himself?
