# Nigeria's New Constitution Your Questions Answered

## No. 2. AIMS OF THE NEW CONSTITUTION THE MINISTERS

**Question 7.** It is said that the new Constitution gives greater responsibility to Nigerians in conducting their own affairs. How is this achieved?

**Answer:** There are to be larger and more representative Legislatures with wider powers both in the Regions and at the Centre. The Regional Legislative Assemblies will have much greater freedom to conduct affairs in their own Region and Nigerians are to be given a full share in the shaping of Governmental policy and the conduct of executive Government action both in the Regions and at the Centre. Twelve Members of the House of Representatives (Legislative Council) will become members of the Council of Ministers (Executive Council) and will hold a majority of seats on this policy forming body. Similarly an Executive Council will be set up in each Region, the majority of Members being Members of the Regional Houses. The Regional Houses will have legislative powers in certain subjects.

**Question 8.** To what extent are the Legislatures to be enlarged?

**Answer:** In the Northern House of Assembly there will be 90 elected members, ten special members and four officials. In the Northern House of Chiefs and the Western House of Chiefs there will be 50 Chiefs and 2 officials. In the Western and Eastern Houses of Assembly there will be 30 elected members, 3 special members and in the West four and in the East five officials. At present there are only 20 Nigerian members of the Northern Assembly, 10 in the Western Assembly and 10 in the Eastern Assembly. In the central legislature, which will be known as the House of Representatives, it is proposed that there should be 148 seats of which 138 will be filled by elected members. In the present Legislative Council there are 15 members (including the President) of whom 25 are Nigerian (official members).

**Question 9.** What is the greater freedom which is to be given to Regional Legislatures?

**Answer:** Under the present Constitution the Regional Legislatures have only advisory powers. Under the new Constitution they will have wide powers over legislation and finance within their own Region.

**Question 10.** In what subjects will the Regional Legislatures have power to legislate?

**Answer:** Regional Houses of Assembly may make laws on the following subjects, provided the laws do not conflict with major overall Nigerian interests: Agriculture Co-operative Societies; Education; Forestry; Fisheries; Development, regulation and supervision of food industries; Land; Local Government; Native Courts (but not including appeals from Native to any other courts); Public Health and Sanitation; Hospitals and Dispensaries; Housing; Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages; Burial and Burial Grounds; Regional Public Works; Taxation to such an extent as may be prescribed by or under an Order of His Majesty in Privy Council; Public Debt of the Region; Town and Country Planning; Animal Health; Social Welfare; Conservation of Soil and Water.

**Question 11.** Who will decide policy in the Regions and at the Centre?

**Answer:** Regional Executive Councils in the Regions; the Council of Ministers at the Centre.

### THE MINISTERS

**Question 12.** What will be the composition of the Central Council of Ministers?

**Answer:** The Central Council of Ministers will consist of the Governor who will be President, twelve Ministers, four coming from each Region and six official Members who will be the Chief Secretary of the three Lieutenant-Governors, the Financial Secretary and the Attorney-General.

**Question 13.** What will be the powers of the Central Council of Ministers?

**Answer:** The Council of Ministers will be the policy forming body over all Central subjects and over any matter which is deemed to be of overall Nigerian interest. It is this body which in future will decide the policy of Nigeria as a whole. The decisions of the Council to so far as they require legislation or entail the expenditure of public funds will be subject to the approval of the House of Representatives.

**Question 14.** Have Ministers any further powers or duties?

**Answer:** Ministers with Portfolios for Central subjects will be responsible for—

- submitting to the Council of Ministers questions relating to matters for which they have been made responsible;
  - engaging in association with the appropriate public officers, that effect is given to decisions taken by the Council of Ministers relating to such matters;
  - conducting in the House of Representatives Government business relating to such matters.
- Central Ministers responsible for Regional subjects will be responsible as in (a) and (c) above. Responsibility for (b) will devolve on the Regional Ministers concerned.

**Question 15.** Does this mean that the Council of Ministers takes over the functions of the Executive Council?

**Answer:** Yes, as regards the formulation of policy, but the Council of Ministers will have much wider powers than the former Executive Council.

**Question 16.** Will Ministers have any special position in the House of Representatives?

**Answer:** The Ministers and other Members of the Council of Ministers will sit as a Government Bench in the House.

**Question 17.** What will be the composition of the Regional Executive Councils?

**Answer:** In each Region the Lieutenant-Governor will preside over the Executive Council, which in the North and West will consist of not less than six or more than nine Ministers, and in the East of not less than seven or more than nine Ministers. In each case there will be not more than five official Members of the Council.

**Question 18.** What will be their powers?

**Answer:** Regional Executive Councils will have similar powers within the Region to those exercised by the Central Council of Ministers in respect of Nigeria.

**Question 19.** Will Ministers in the Regions have portfolios?

**Answer:** Yes. Certain Ministers in each Region will be responsible for subjects for which the Houses of Assembly will have power to legislate.
