VACANCIES IN UNIVERSITIES AND OTHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS IN THE UNITED KINGDOM FOR THE 1952-53 SESSION.

The Secretary of State for the Colonies has notified the Government that the vacancies upon Universities and Colleges in the United Kingdom has been as great as ever during the past year and the position is not expected to become any easier in the immediate future. There is, therefore, an likelihood of an increase in the number of Colonial Students whom University authorities will be willing to admit in the 1952/53 Session. It is, however, most important that the difficulty of securing places for all suitable candidates is becoming more acute. It is, therefore, most important that the University Colleges, in the advantage of their respective spheres for preparing their students in the United Kingdom.

2. The Secretary of State will, however, make every effort to secure as many vacancies as possible for well qualified and properly sponsored Colonial Students and to render it possible for the necessary arrangements to be made. It is necessary that full particulars of all students wishing to proceed to the United Kingdom for further studies in 1952 should be forwarded to the Secretary, Students' Advisory Committee, Nigerian Students' Bureau by 31st December, 1951. In the case of students applying for places in the following categories, the Advisory Committee, Nigerian Students' Bureau, Lagos, will later than the 15th of November, 1951—

- (a) Courses in Medicine, Dentistry, Engineering and Pure Science.
- (b) Teachers' training courses (including physical training, Domestic Science and Practical or other kindergarten training) for which the sponsorship of the Ministry of Education is required.
- (c) Applicants for admission to Oxford or Cambridge Colleges.
- (d) Applicants for admission to other institutions for advancement in science, in the department of Agriculture in the United Kingdom (a copy of which may be obtained from the Secretary to the Students' Advisory Committee, Nigerian Students' Bureau, the name of the University or College, or Institution which the student would wish to attend should be stated, but as under the present circumstances it is impossible to guarantee places, a student can be admitted to the place selected by him, when a few suggestions should also be recorded. All applications should be accompanied by:—

- (a) Originals of examination and other certificates together with 3 copies.
- (b) A list of references of fitness. This must include an X-ray examination of the Chest and be on the special form obtainable from the Secretary, Students' Advisory Committee together with 4 copies.
- (c) A testimonial of character from the candidate's Headmaster or other School Authority. This should give a brief appreciation of both the applicant's intellectual capacity and of his personal qualities with special reference to his ability to adapt himself to the various activities of life of a University or similar institution in the United Kingdom. It is desirable that such testimonial and is in employment, or a testimonial from the employer or Head of Department must be obtained. (Original copies of testimonial should be submitted to the student in two folders, who are not members of the applicant's family, to whom reference may be made).
- (d) Three copies of a recent photograph.
- (e) A written undertaking from the person or persons who will be responsible financially for the candidate's return passage, maintenance and other expenses in the United Kingdom throughout the period of study (2 original and 3 copies).
- (f) A Sworn Declaration of Age or Birth Certificate in original with four copies.
- (g) Candidates who have been in correspondence with institutions in the United Kingdom should forward replies received from the institutions together with copies of the replies.

20275. All copies of documents required above should be submitted on separate papers.

Students who desire to take full degree courses in the United Kingdom or technical courses of similar standard should give full details of the studies they have pursued subsequent to the taking of the School Certificate or equivalent examination. Evidence of suitability for particular technical qualifications is also required. For example, when a candidate applies for a course in Architecture it is necessary to provide evidence of his special ability in drawing.

Applicants who have been in employment since leaving School should give full details of such employment together with the names (if) and addresses (if) of his employer(s).

5. The Secretary of State has stressed that it is most undesirable that word for candidates should proceed to the United Kingdom unaccompanied and unprepared in the hope of gaining admission to Universities, Tutorial Colleges, Polytechnics or similar institutions. Such establishments are overburdened with long waiting lists of candidates and it is almost impossible to gain admission to such institutions without due notice in the proper form.

6. It is particularly important that students should not go to the United Kingdom for pre-arranged relation results via third

But if they proceed to the United Kingdom unaccompanied, it will be in their own best interests if they notify the Secretary to the Students' Advisory Committee some time before their departure so that the Director of Colonial Schools may be informed.

7. Government is anxious to give the greatest possible assistance to students who are unable to attend their own Universities or Colleges proceeding to the United Kingdom. It is, therefore, most important that the Secretary of State should be notified in the proper form for consideration. His attention will be greatly assisted if students carefully state and carry out the requests in this notice.
