FROM DENIGA'S "NOTES ON LAGOS STREETS."

(Copyright)

Historical Notes of the Principal Streets in town through which His Royal Highness accompanied by His Excellency the Governor, will drive on Tuesday the 14th instant at 10 a.m.

MARINA (BHINGBEJI).

This is named thus, owing to its being the chief place in which all refuse and dirt is generally deposited in the early days of Lagos.

TINURU SQUARE.

This important Square, on which stands the Courthouse, is named after a lady by the name of Shuoroy Tinubu an Eba, that may be said to have been the Head of Lagos in years gone by; she came over from Abeokuta to this country through Badagry and carried on a most flourishing trade in Tobacco, etc. and was possessed of many slaves. She owned the present site of the Lagos Police Force, which it is said, she gave to the late Captain J. P. L. Davies in satisfaction of a debt. She left Lagos for Abeokuta on Tuesday 13th April, 1856, never to return.

BROAD STREET.

This is a principal thoroughfare. It extends from the Ric. Course the Fields, to Parade Square, Ote Owo-ogbowo a distance of about 11 miles or 7722 feet or 1200 links.

VICTORIA ROAD.

This is named after Queen Victoria, popularly known as Victoria the Good on account of her peaceful reign; she was born in 1819 Ascended the Throne 1837; Joined the great majority January 21, 1901.

HALOGUN STREET OR SQUARE.

This spot is named after a man Ajenla by name whose official title is the Ensign of 1200; he began to flourish during King Akoko's time and took a very active part in all the wars of that time.

AKIRIMANU.

Wales, H. R. H. the Prince of. Edward Albert
Christian George Andrew Patrick David, born
June 23, 1894. Received royal training at Osborne and
Bathurst; obtained a whistling pair in the Harcourt
Regatta, 1910. Invested as Prince of Wales at Cnaron, 1911.
Married Miss Wallis Simpson, former companion of his, train-
ing, less than week-early last winter, and her stuck in all
three aboard him, King and Queen, as what we call a "live
Eating". Met, June, 1911. Stayed some months in Paris,
acquainting himself with France and the language in 1912.
Received the Legion of Honor from the President July 1, 1921
and the Cross de Guerre (October 1915). Promoted
Lieutenant on account of taking a tour in Germany, March, 1913.
West through an interval since known as Magdalen College,
Oxford. Promoted to the rank of Captain by Royal Commission
of S. Augustus' Church, Romanians, in June, 1914.
Went to the front in Nov., 1914, attached to Sir J. French's
Staff. Served with great and credit, and was the best of
historic despatch from Sir J. French respecting the battle of
Rouen Chateau. Cleverly avoided a costly loss at birth, say
June, 1915, the Queen of the Annamites was given him
by the King of Italy in Ju'y. Arrived in Egypt in March,
1916, on appointment as Staff-captain on the Staff of the
General Officer commanding the Mediterranean Expeditionary Force. Has since been a Q.M.A.C. in May, Appointed - in
July, 1917, hon. C.S.Q.A. to a captain in the Cheshire Reg-
iment, appointed Grand Master of the Order of St. Michael
and George. Visited Italian troops during Austria's attack on
Nov. 1917. Took his seat in the House of Lord
Pub. '18. Appointed Q.M.A.C. in Feb. 1918, first of the Queen's
Corps. Appointed Major in Feb. 1918. Recruit
Recruits with much success to no longer, May, 1918. Rec-
ruits with the Guards on their study into London for review by

the King, March, 1919. Appointed Colonel-in-Chief of the
1st Lancers and Royal Scots Fusiliers, April, 1919. Be-
cause Freeman of the City of London, in May, and High
Steward of Plymouth in June. Sponsored for a visit to Canada
and U.S.A., August, 1919, and upon universal popularity
made several excellent speeches and undertaken many new
enterprises. Had a separate home at St. James's Palace, Bevan
Street, 10, 1920, a long time in Australia, returning in
Oct., '21, after covering 4500 miles and doing splendid
service. Received a treat welcome in London. Visited
Glasgow in March, 1921. Appointed for Boy Scouts' Picnic
and a large amount was recovered. Gained and with great
success a long list of public engagements in 1921. Q.M.A.C.
and Q.M.C. conferred on several of a voyage to India, Oct., 1921.
Was kindly warmly received in India, Japan, and returned
to England June 23, 1922. Received a Knighthood of the Thistle
on his birthday in 1923. Held a short review of a year of public
service in 1923. Visited his Canadian ranch in September.

In February, 1924, opened new sewage facilities at Miss
Hill School, and performed a review of other public duties.
Wembley Exhibition drew much to his enthusiastic support.

**H. R. H. PRINCE OF WALES' SPEECH
AT
THE ANNUAL CIVIL SERVICE DINNER IN LONDON.**

First-wicket stands are all the fashion just now. But when I look down the order of going in—I mean the toast at—(laughter) and see the great bassmen who are to follow me! It is not for me to try to emulate either Hobbs or Siddle. (Laughter.) Though I feel to-night that the wicket is an easy one, I shall not trouble you for many over.

There are two things I must say after the extremely kind way in which you have received this toast. The first is to tell you how glad I am to meet here to-night such a large and representative gathering of Civil servants, and to have the chance of establishing the same personal association with you as with the other three Services. (Cheers.) I am delighted, too, to see representatives of the great Services with us. Their presence here makes this an assembly not only of the State workers of Great Britain, but of the whole of the Empire. (Hear, hear.) The task of preparing the toast of H.M. Civil Service has fallen, very appropriately, to the Prime Minister. I do not envy him so task, because it would be very difficult, if not impossible, to express in words the extent of the debt which this country owes to succeeding generations of Civil servants who, as Government follows Government, have never failed to serve her with unquestioned loyalty and efficiency. (Cheers.) It is not for me to enlarge on this subject to-night. I could add, however, sit down without paying my tribute to a Service which, with all my fellow-countrymen, I recognise as good in every sense of the word. (Cheers.)

The other thing I want to say concerns the sport of the service and your schemes for organizing it on a solid basis. I am going to risk what I should call a very silly old pre-war joke—so old that I cannot remember it (laughter)—it was only told me to-day. It is that the Civil servants are like the fountains in Trafalgar Square—(laughter)—because they play from to till 4. (Laughter.)

It is just as absurd as the old saying, "all work and no play," etc., is true. I certainly think Civil servants should play—not necessarily from 10 to 4. (Laughter.) Perhaps I can in a way put myself in your position, because we do not always feel in the best of tempers and up to all our work. If we get a chance of a game or of getting out, it does us better than anything else. (Hear, hear.) These who work at mental occupations for their livelihood do their work all the better if they can keep themselves physically fit, and if any of you, any days of the year, can play from 10 to 4 (laughter), all the better.

Words fail me to express very adequately how jubilant we the local and dutiful subjects of His Majesty the King in his Royal Dependency are, in welcoming Your Royal Highness to our shores : it is an open secret to say that since the last occupation of this country on August 6 1861, during the reign of King Dosemo, we have never been privileged to see him to record the visit of any member of the Royal, beyond the seas, let alone that of an Heir apparent to the British Throne such as Your Royal Highness, to this part of His Majesty's Dominions.

Writing from memory I believe that of all the colonies in British West Africa—and in this I am open to correction—our colony of Sierra Leone alone was the first to enjoy the Royal visit in the year 1860 of His Royal Highness Prince Alfred, an occasion which was very significant inasmuch that one of our own flesh and blood in the person of G. W. Johnson, popularly known in after years as the Reverend Johnson, Father of the Igbo United Government, came under the notice of the Royal Visitor with the happy result that the young African became as it were, the bridge of His Royal Highness who eventually sent him to Europe for more training during those halcyon days.

To my Sir, that it has given us unqualified pleasure nay, almost opportunity to see Your Royal Highness face to face, as a man talketh to his friend—to borrow a theological terminology, is to give expression to poverty of language but we have that confident assurance, having regard to Your Royal Highness's social dispositions and sportsmanship that in Your Royal Highness is found that magnanimous vein as depicted by Cowper :—

"Flaky locks and black complexion

Cause Ineffe Nature's claim ;

Skins may differ, but aspirations and affections

Dwell in Black and White the same, (Ital es, mine)

The only remarkable episode is the rift in the political life of this country occasioned by the ill-favour into which the accredited HEAD of our African community has fallen in the hands of "the powers that be" during the last five years, and would in GOD, Your Royal Highness sympathise with your people in this their present predicament.

During Your Royal Highness's stay in our midst, and throughout Your Royal Highness's 20,000 mile tour, may success in its thousand fold attend and crown Your Royal Highness's progress and egress.
