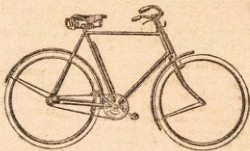

"I am bewildered on reading in the Lagos Weekly Record of May 23rd what purports to be an eye witness's account of an interview between a responsible political officer and the white cap Chiefs of Lagos. I begin by dwelling upon three vital points; first that the native rulers of Nigeria were entirely loyal during the Great War, in which also they rendered gallant personal service and contributed liberally in money and kind; second, that they gave to the Prince a reception to the enthusiastic loyalty of which H.R.H. bore warm testimony; third, that it is a cardinal principle of policy for local governments to cultivate the good-will and support of the Chiefs, upon whom they largely rely x x x x x. The report asserts that the Chiefs were summoned to the presence of the Political Officer x x x x x but the main point is that, over and over again the Chiefs were raked by the officer and called "fools, stupid fools, old fools, monkey, fishermen, idiots and liars, and told not to come again to him until they had apologized."

"What was their offence? They were asked why had not taken part in the (Lagos) proceedings in honour of the departing Governor. This suggests that in the officer's view Chiefs (and, obviously, even more so the ordinary public) must extend loyalty, or courtesy to the Governor personally and individually. This would be startling doctrine, I imagine, to most people in Great Britain. The

Chiefs, it is well known, differed from the Governor on a matter of policy, affecting the Ekko. They therefore asserted themselves from the farewell proceedings. Was this unlawful? If so, it should be so stated, by Oyinbo. If not, it is preposterous for any Political Officer to address censure to any African who exercised his right of keeping apart from any public ceremony, in those of the Governor or any other public official, in those are British subjects to take part in Christmas in Lagos, or are British subjects to take part in Christmas in those of Governors and whether, if they refuse so to take part, they render themselves liable to abusive censure. If they commit an offence in so acting their punishment should not stop at abusive censure. Clearly they should be prosecuted criminally. And the population in general should be warned that not to attend the departure of Governor was open to prosecution. The point should be decided, one way or the other. I hope in justice to all concerned, the Political Officer not least, this incident will be inquired into.
