



IBADAN AND OYO-NEWS AND NOTES.

[From our Correspondent.]

Death of Durojaiye Ishola Thomas, the Isalogun, Igbimo Alafin, otherwise known as Oyo Mesi, at his residence Agunpopo, on Thursday the 2nd August 1923.

The funeral took place on Friday 3rd August 1923 in the presence of his children, Messrs Joseph B. Thomas, Sanitary Inspector, and Daniel O. Thomas, Licensed Customs Agent, who have come up from Lagos a few days before the sad event amidst an overwhelming crowd of people both Christians, Mohammedans and Pagans. Conspicuous of those who attended the funeral ceremonies were the following:-

The representatives of the Alafin, the Arewo, Prince Saúsi Oṣidigbóla, the Bashorun, Asipa, Oṣun-Efa, Osi-Eta, Ono-Efa, Alapin, Onosoke, Agunpopo, Ilagbenka, Ifijani, Alfa Gboro, Iya Alagbon, Iya-Ori, Iya-Lagure

Saiyere, Lagunro, Baba-Iyagi, Oyin-Ayaba, Iwasimi, Kudefin, the Revd. S. A. Sedipe, C.M.S. Agunpopo Church, Mr. S. I. Taiwo, Dispenser of Baptist Dispensary, Oke Isokun, Mr. S. M. Akidele, the Alafin's confidential Clerk and Mr. Edwin Cole, personal clerk to Captain Ross, the Resident of Oyo.

The deceased Balogun has suffered for a very long period from certain protracted illness. He is a younger brother of that popular Auctioneer, Mr. Andrew Thomas of the Palatial Buildings 83 Odunfa Street, Lagos, and also first Consul of H.H. Oladigbóla, C.M.G., the Alafin of Oyo. And both have lost a living and respectable member of the family and a sound councillor by his death. To the Alafin and Mr. Andrew Thomas we tender our sincere sympathy.

On Tuesday 6th August 1923 the Funeral Obsequies and feasting were observed according to customs by the Alafin and no less than 300 guests were present and entertained at the Palace. Several Cows having been killed a day or two before, feasting and drinking continued till midnight. Various kinds of Drums were at play and dancing was indulged in by all and sundry including the Christian Ladies and Gentlemen to the strain of Native airs. Conspicuous of those present at the Palace were Mrs. Victoria Mokolu, Mrs. Layton West, Comfort Abge, Ashiyambawa Taylor, Adeyemi Green, Henrietta Alakija, Messrs. J. Onosalewa Thomas, J. B. Thomas, Dan. O. Thomas, and Bankole Thomas all from Lagos.

At Ibadan Station on Friday 10th August 1923 one Constable No. 269 stopped the Alafin's car out of sheer grudge or previous animosity against the Driver, and without any just cause. The car contained passengers (the Thomas's family) from Oyo. The master was brought before the Police Commissioner, Mr. Nolans; the Constable failed to give satisfactory explanations or reasons for his misbehaviour for he was very rude to the passengers consisting chiefly of women and children. He also displayed high temper, obstinacy and disobedience at the decision of his superior Officers. He was reduced to lower grade. This will certainly serve as an example to those foolish set of Constables one generally meets about up-country. Commissioner Nolans is an Officer of great experience and deserves our special praise.

The New Legislative Council of Nigeria. It is the opinion of the educated people at Ibadan and Oyo that in Mr. Andrew W. Thomas we saw a fit and proper person to represent our country. Others as experienced and capable consist chiefly of Priests in Holy Orders who should not meddle with politics.

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

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
