DADA ADESIGBIN.

Merchant: dropped his foreign name "Moses" in after years; educated in St. Paul's (Benedictine) School, Lagos, started his "Business before Pleasure" campaign into prominence by his famous Singer Sewing Machine business; presented a donation of 120 guineas to his Church betel on attaining the age of 45, 1910; has published Annual Almanacs of African life (illustrated); lost his eldest son 30 in Sierra Leone (whether he had gone for further training) during the Influenza Epidemic 1918, visited Europe and America in company with Mr. E. A. T. A. Johnson of this country who played the part of "Private Secretary" to him, 1905.

Joined the great majority on Sunday 8th February, 1925. Aged 60 years.—From Nigerian *Who's Who*.

FACTS AND FIGURES.

Sir Harry Johnston On An All-Black Republic.

MARCUS GARVEY'S IDEA SUPPORTED BY THE GREATEST EUROPEAN AUTHORITY ON AFRICA.

The following extracts appeared in the *Afro-American* (6/11/25) :—

"Looks for a big Black Republic in Africa"—London *Express*, January 7. (By A. N. P.)—In an interview here recently, Sir Harry Johnston, the empire builder, who served on Rhodesia, Uganda and Nyasa, the Great Britain during his forty years in Africa, told a correspondent for the *Chicago Daily News* that he visioned a vast republic for the colored races playing its part in the balance of world power. In the coming clash of color which he envisioned, white control in Africa will be imperilled and the heart of the dark continent will again begin to glow.

"I don't expect to see a black Africa in my time," said Sir Harry, who is 66. "However, it is entirely possible that within half a century all of Africa from the Zambesi to the Great Sahara may be one great black republic."

Points To Liberia As Keynote—Many considerations go to indicate the eventual success of a black dominion throughout Africa. The deadly climate in the central regions—the Congo and the Cameroons—a climate absolutely fatal to whites, is one factor. The encouraging success of

Liberia in being able to maintain its identity is another. The rising desire for independence—the following title of color—is yet another."

"Many of the Negro and Negroid tribes in Africa are fully capable of independence and unless their political instincts are depressed by the progress of whites they should be able to take care of themselves. The African type of head is a fine type of head."

Sir Harry is usually considered the greatest living authority on Africa. He went out to the Congo in 1886, worked with Stanley. His scientific discoveries and researches have made him even more widely known. For two decades he collected fauna, flora, geology and made an especial study of its language. He is the author of the only available work in English on the Bantu tongues.

After all said and done Marcus Garvey's dream of an African Republic is not as fantastic as some people have been trying to make it. It is not impossible of realization. At present it appears very dark to many but if things continue some day. The fact that no less an authority on Africa than Harry Johnston (of *Africanism*) could envision the same idea is an evidence that it is nothing that should cause us alarm if we are not indifferent to facts. But alas, some critics—are they fanatics?—have shrouded themselves in the shade of the water, raising alarm over the idea of a Black Republic. Do these critics believe that the Negro is an GOOD A MAN as the Europeans will throw out.
