MINNA.

Thursday 6th to Friday 7th and Monday 10th to Tuesday 11th inst. there were heavy rainfalls and almost throughout last week there were no end of down-pour of rain. It is believed that the heavy rainfall on the above dates were general throughout Nigeria. On the 10th instant there

was a general washout of the Railway line at Baro, Sarkin Pawa and Akerra.

The damage at Baro being slight in comparison to the others, that line was repaired and better late than never the Baro train arrived here at 6. p.m. instead of the schedule time at 4. p.m. Immediately the passengers alighted, the rain which had been falling the previous night started again up to dawn of day. It was a pitiable sight indeed to see the passengers—some of them complete strangers, compelled to stop at Minna due to the wash-out, trodding along to find a place for shelter for that night. Those who were going beyond Zaria waited the Lagos train, the others joined the Local Train the next day.

The Baro train was detailed to go up and bring the Kano-Lagos passengers from Sarkin Pawa to Akerra and from Akerra to take the Lagos-Kano train to Sarkin Pawa. Passengers are being carried up and down by means of transhipment.

Among the passengers who arrived here from Baro on the 11th instant were Mr. H. C. C. Bridger, Assistant Auditor and his Clerk, Mr. C. A. Clerk who after inspection duties at Lokofa are passing up to Kano and Jos and thence to Kaduna. They left here on the early morning of the 13 inst. at about 3. a. m.

By the Passenger train which arrived here on the 14th inst. at 2. a.m. with the Lagos-Kano passengers was Mr. R. L. Jones of the Provincial Office from Sierra Leone resuming duty. He appears to have had a very enviable time at home. To him we wish Berka da zua.

We see that from the beginning of this month the game of Chacha is being played in several places in town here. It is the custom among the Hausas to play Chacha for seven days when there is a marriage for the celebration of it. It is remarkable we have more marriages this month than ever before. In one compound alone there have been three marriages under different dates this month, hence in that particular compound there are more than six different sets of Chacha players.

Thieves are prevalent now in town. It may in some ways be due to the multiplicity of chacha.

On the night of the 10th instant an Hausa man who on his way going to Comusie, Gold Coast for the purposes of trading and who is temporarily staying in the near neighbourhood of Mr. Jones, Chief Fitter, Nigeria Railway was robbed of seven cloths and 10/-.

DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

Notice of Scholarship Examination.

A new course of Agricultural Training will commence at Moor Plantation, Ibadan, in November 1925. Entrance examinations will be held simultaneously at Lagos, Ibadan, Asaba and Calabar on Saturday October 3rd 1925. Candidates will be examined in English, Mathematics and General knowledge. Twenty candidates will be selected and will be given free passages to Ibadan where they will undergo a preliminary course of training of three months duration. During this period they will receive £3 per month. Fifteen scholarships of £15 per annum for three years together with free tuition and quarters, will then be awarded.

The remaining five probationary pupils will be given free passages to their homes. Intending candidates should apply not later than September 26th.

(a) To the Education Department, Lagos, for permission to sit at Lagos. or

(b) To the Supt. of Agriculture, Benin, for permission to sit at Asaba. or

(c) To the Supt. of Agriculture, Umahia, for permission to sit at Calabar. or

(d) To the Botanist, Ibadan, for permission to sit at Ibadan.

Candidates residing in the Northern Provinces should apply direct to the Department of Agriculture, Ibadan. Should sufficient applications be received, arrangements will be made to hold an examination in the Northern Provinces.

Permission to sit will be confined to applicants who have passed Standard Six examination or its equivalent.

In addition to scholarship holders, the course is open to approved students who are willing to bear their own expenses. Such students will be given free quarters and tuition. Application to join the course under these conditions should be made to the Agricultural Department, Ibadan direct.

Notice of Scholarship Examination.

A new course of Agricultural Training will commence at Moor Plantation, Ibadan, in November 1925. Entrance examinations will be held simultaneously at Lagos, Ibadan, Asaba and Calabar on Saturday October 3rd 1925. Candidates will be examined in English, Mathematics and General knowledge. Twenty candidates will be selected and will be given free passages to Ibadan where they will undergo a preliminary course of training of three months duration. During this period they will receive £3 per month. Fifteen scholarships of £45 per annum for three years together with free tuition and quarters, will then be awarded.

The remaining five probationary pupils will be given free passages to their homes. Intending candidates should apply not later than September 26th.

(a) To the Education Department, Lagos, for permission to sit at Lagos. or

(b) To the Supt. of Agriculture, Benin, for permission to sit at Asaba. or

(c) To the Supt. of Agriculture, Umunna, for permission to sit at Calabar. or

(d) To the Botanist, Ibadan, for permission to sit at Ibadan.

Candidates residing in the Northern Provinces should apply direct to the Department of Agriculture, Ibadan. Should sufficient applications be received, arrangements will be made to hold an examination in the Northern Provinces.

Permission to sit will be confined to applicants who have passed Standard Six examination or its equivalent.

In addition to scholarship holders, the course is open to approved students who are willing to bear their own expenses. Such students will be given free quarters and tuition. Application to join the course under these conditions should be made to the Agricultural Department, Ibadan direct.
