To the Editor of "Eko Akete"

Sir,

Please permit me to put before you the un-civilised conduct played by those who called themselves Christians at Ikorodu.

Two months ago a man by name Mr. D. O. Legunjen was written to by the Ikorodu Unity Club established in Lagos to preside on Xmas day over their "Sport." This gentleman replied the Club in a letter dated 5/11/22 at Ikorodu giving his consent and his members to attend the play, and the members of the said Club paid him a visit on 3/12/22 and separated with good spirit after the notices were printed and placarded right round the Town of Ikorodu rumours came out that this Club was composed of nothing but members Brotherhood Christian Church then the people of the Town were prevailed upon not to attend; also letters were written round the Churches of C.M.S., Wesleyan, and Bethel that this people who are coming will bias their members and induce them to join their own Church. (Brotherhood.)

The announcement was made in the Ikorodu Churches on Sunday the 17th Dec. 1922 (a week's time pre the sport.) On the Sport Day being Christmas Day the Christians were all at home but none of them (C.M.S. Wesleyan and Bethel) ventured to attend the Sport, if memory serves me well you could only see one Bethelite on the stage.

But God will not leave His people for the play was a splendid one ever performed even more than what members expected though the attendance are Mohammedans and Pagans and the addresses were delivered by Messrs Ladega, Akalehin Johnson and one Mohammedan whose name escaped me, spoke on the words of encouragement and unity etc., etc.

The play was closed with a song by the members thus :-

God bless the Boys 'Krodu, Our future hope
and joy

Grant all that may be needful,

For life and godliness;

The Boys of happy 'Krodu,

Bless them at home, abroad

God bless the Boys and maidens

O God, Our fathers' God!

The play came to an end at 7 p.m.

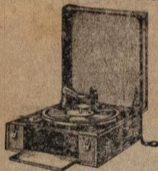
