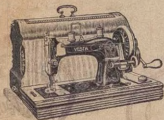

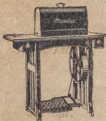

TO CELEBRITIES, NOTORITIES, ETC., IN DIFFERENT

WALKS OF LIFE.

TO HIS EXCELLENCY

SIR DONALD CAMERON, K.C.B., C.M.G.:

Acting Governor.

Government House.

Nigeria.

YOUR EXCELLENCY,

Your generation in winding-up the business of the last Legislative Council, under the old regime, as contained in the proceedings of that august body which came under my notice recently in a noteworthy, particularly when in a very fitting manner, you congratulated honourable members on its demise in these characteristic lines:

"Honourable Members of the Legislative Council of the Colony of Nigeria:

You are all aware that the new Letters Patent and Orders in Council referred to in the Ordinances passed to-day come into effect on the 1st June, 1923, by virtue of a Proclamation recently issued on the 24th July; in consequence this Honourable Council will cease to exist on May 31st next and, as there is no more business to be transacted as far as can be seen, this will probably be the last time Honourable Members will be summoned to this Council. The Legislative Council of the Colony of Nigeria will thus cease to exist after a life of over nine years.

It is not my intention to deliver a eulogical oration on the present occasion. To be frank—and there is no reason to dissemble my views—I experience a sensation of joy rather than of regret at its demise; in the course of a Council which for the past nine years has had no financial control and only very fragmentary powers of legislation, it will cease to exist and will be succeeded by a Council endowed with a generous measure of financial control and with legislative powers of a much wider description. These increased powers will prove, I hope, a potent power in shaping and directing the changes and the destinies of this great Dependency. This Council will die, but from its ashes I shall I say, I will arise another and stronger body in which, for the first time in the history of British West Africa, representatives of the people directly elected by themselves will be able to give expression to the views and aspirations of the inhabitants not only of the Colony but also of the Town of Calabar. I wish you, Honourable Members, an unambiguous farewell and declare that this Council do stand adjourned without date.

It goes without saying that your Excellency welcomes the Dawn of the New Era, widely recognized as evidenced from your speech which can safely be said to be the zenith of power of a Burke or a Sheridan in the republic of letters: Nigeria, I make bold to say, is greatly indebted to you. Sir, for this frank pronouncement on a subject which the bulk of the inhabitants of this growing Dependency have feared; and it is, I think, a matter of no small satisfaction that those of our "colours—the old contemplables, shall I say—who, during the last few years, have shuddered themselves hoarse in utterance than one, against the introduction of this most important measure of Representative Government, will be thoroughly ashamed of themselves on reading your speech, as to ejaculate "amen!!!"

Your Excellency is by nature, a man of few words with a large amount of administrative tact and experience, and your view such as the above, will undoubtedly be treasured up by many an African, as coming as it does, from one whose noble aim is always to dispense even-handed justice to all without fear or favour, affection or ill-will.

Countrymen, Hats off to Sir Donald Cameron!!!
