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

THE FOREMOST MAN.

M. Poincaré is the foremost man in European politics of today. French President 1913-17, was a staunch ally of Britain during the world-war 1914-18. Lawyer and politician, has great influence in his country. Peace and war are at his bidding. He is also a way in Europe, mark. He held Germany bound in the Kiel and other wars in his sphere of influence in the Rhine and other parts of Germany occupied by the French. (When I say peace and war are at this bidding, I do not mean that the French President may instigate another war but simply that he has the European situation in hand by his masterly and magnificent pol'-y). He is rightly or wrongly called "windjammer" because it is of such nature that he would break no flaw of form in the afflict dominoes from Germany to try to her detriment equally, the lastlines incurred by her during the war (1914-18) that she had initiated and that she must

not be allowed the remote chances of getting on her feet as a world power for the second time before passing her tribulities.

Private property, hideous taints, and an ignis fatuus form our chief defects in Nigeria, especially in Lagos. By the power of literary rhetoric, every patriotic clowns is argued down to the conviction of a few self-righting Holy writ, and a literate mind must be some qua nunc in responsible quarters. Liberality of sentiment must not be an offence necessarily. Distinctive conservatism and an undesignable object to a large portion of the so-called advanced and more enlightened class among us. Liberal opinion is essential to our existence as a race and we're hopeful outlook on things will bring us nearer and nearer to our desired haven. Loyalty to Nigeria, as no less a portion of the British Commonwealth which Great Britain as a European pointed out sometime ago in one of our local papers. The educated franchise is quite contradictive to the Saxon. (Happily unsatisfied) advocated by some. Political parties have already been formed in the country. Are these parties called into existence as permanent institutions or do they exist for the time being, as long as the current of events of late last? Or are these three parties concurrent with these events only? That is the anxious question of the moment. It is wellknown, indeed, that these political parties to wit Democratic Party, Peoples' Union, Young Nigerian, and Reform Club are of diversified opinions concerning political matters, but we sincerely hope that they will not differ as to the things that really matter. The total elimination of clear prejudice in the fight over hero of the hour is putting on now in remote France and may the efforts of M. Poincaré and his noble neighbour receive among his British allies so that the British dominions may once more know an unshackled exercise of their liberties and privileges and that the magnanimity of the French Premier may triumph over all adverse forces so that all antinomies may be swallowed up in joy of emancipated humanity is going and praise of God.
