I blush to read of your Segregation Sermon which you were said to have delivered in St. Jude's, Ebute Meta, on Sunday the 4th instant according to the *Nigerian Advocate* of the 7th instant.

The Chapter of your alleged text viz.—II Corinthians Chapter 9 as noted in the journal was, I believe, misquoted for II Corinthians, Chapter 6, Verse 17; but the context, viz.—“Come ye out among them, and be ye separate, and touch not the unclean thing” evidently betrays you as a man who although not ashamed to leave his country 4000 miles away, to seek his bread-and-butter in blackman’s land, with a personal emolument of £1,500 from £300, duty pay, whatever this latter sum may mean in official terminology, yet does not scruple to preach segregation even in God’s Temple or a lame plea, viz.—that “segregation was necessary between Whites and the Natives.....in order to avoid the possibility of infecting the whitemen with the plague carrying germs.”

Now that White and Black, with particular reference to this country, are fostering, very vigorously, as never before, the spirit of true BROTHERHOOD between them, Rādyard Kipling’s dictum “East is East, and West is West, and never the twain shall meet,” notwithstanding, for you apparently an Apostle of suffering humanity to be thus engaged in widening rather than in bridging over the gulf of race-hatred for reasons best known to yourself, is neither politic nor wise.

You will doubtless on reflection, agree with me that your action in this respect is nothing short of a GOSPEL OF DESPAIR.

Now, then, Thomas Blane Adam, it is high time you bury THE OLD ADAM in you.
