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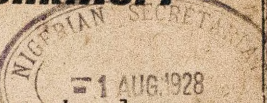

I gather that what will now happen in the Eleko affair is that the case will go back to Lagos for a fresh hearing at which the judge will have placed before him a considerable amount of new evidence. What the effect of that evidence will be, nobody, of course, will know until the Lagos court gives its decision. It may be stated with certainty that if the decision is adverse to the claimant the whole matter will then come before the Privy Council as a main appeal. That stage, if reached, is not likely to be reached this year.—*West Africa*, 30/6/28.

#### INCOME TAX COLLECTION.

There is much complaint—and quite reasonable complaint—among a large number of the clerk class both in government and trading establishments against the present system of tax collection by which they are required to pay at one stroke the whole assessment for the year. We understand in some of the Government Departments the concession is allowed to clerks to pay in two instalments, but this does not appear however to be general. On the other hand employees in trading establishments do not have any such concession. It is undoubtedly a great hardship and would want looking into by the Taxation Department.

There was a movement sometime ago in England sponsored we believe by the Income-tax Payers Association to persuade the Inland Revenue Department to institute a system of collection of taxes by instalment. We do not know how far the movement has succeeded, but in Nigeria we do not think it will be any harder work to make the collection quarterly or half-yearly than yearly in advance as at present. The payment of taxes is certainly not always an agreeable duty and least so in the case of the present income-tax which falls on the people at a time when conditions of life in the country are not the easiest, and no device which can be made to allow the burden to fall as lightly as possible on the taxed should be left untried.

What the effect of that evidence will be, nobody, of course, will know until the Lagos court gives its decision. It may be stated with certainty that if the decision is adverse to the claimant the whole matter will then come before the Privy Council as a main appeal. That stage, if reached, is not likely to be reached this year.—*West Africa*, 30/6/28.

#### INCOME TAX COLLECTION.

There is much complaint—and quite reasonable complaint—among a large number of the clerk class both in government and trading establishments against the present system of tax collection by which they are required to pay at one stroke the whole assessment for the year. We understand in some of the Government Departments the concession is allowed to clerks to pay in two instalments, but this does not appear however to be general. On the other hand employees in trading establishments do not have any such concession. It is undoubtedly a great hardship and would want looking into by the Taxation Department.

There was a movement sometime ago in England sponsored we believe by the Income-tax Payers Association to persuade the Inland Revenue Department to institute a system of collection of taxes by instalment. We do not know how far the movement has succeeded, but in Nigeria we do not think it will be any harder work to make the collection quarterly or half-yearly than yearly in advance as at present. The payment of taxes is certainly not always an agreeable duty and least so in the case of the present income-tax which falls on the people at a time when conditions of life in the country are not the easiest, and no device which can be made to allow the burden to fall as lightly as possible on the taxed should be left untried.
