A CORRECTION.

We have to make this correction that His Honour Major Birrel-Gray, the Administrator of the Colony did not arrive by the *Adida* on the 31st ultimo; our informant was wrong and has misled us; we regret the announcement.

MRS. LYDIA VINCENT FINED.

In connection with excessive corporal punishment inflicted by Mrs. Lydia Vincent on a young girl, her niece, who stayed with her at Evans and Oloji Streets, Oke-Popo, on account of an alleged missing trinkets, His Worship Mr. H. A. Young, in the Police Magistrate Court fittingly and deservedly inflicted on Mrs. Vincent in return a fine of £25 or in default, three months imprisonment on Wednesday, the 7th instant; out of which the sum of £10 as damages to be paid to the injured girl.

This will be a salutary lesson to the cruel and wicked people who have the foolish notion that they can beat their servants to death for any offence whatever.

A SUCCESSFUL DEMONSTRATION OF YORUBA
SONGS FOR THE USE OF OUR CHURCHES.

Mr. Kolawole Ajiṣafé should be congratulated for the successful demonstration of twenty Yoruba Songs for the use of our Churches which was held in the Glover Memorial Hall on Monday the 12th inst. The spacious Hall was taxed to its utmost capacity, and a good number of the audience were standing here and there within its precinct under the Chairmanship of Dr. Ogunṣola Ṣapara, L.S.O., supported by some prominent gentlemen, such as Mr. T. K. E. Phillips, Rev. Jones, Mr. Rueben Taylor; Mr. T. J. O. Ṣoyode, Mr. J. Akiyemi Oṣodi, Mr. A. Ade; Oshodi, Mr. H. Antus Williams, Mr. J. G. Kuyé and several others. Mr. Lasbury being the Master of Ceremony who gave touching addresses before and after the singing of the songs composed by Mr. Kolawole Ajiṣafé. Mr. Ajiṣafé assisted by a Young man alternately accompanied the songs. On the whole the songs were good and in our opinion they are fit for religious worship in our Churches in the light of our present development in native airs and songs. Mr. Ajiṣafé deserved the moral and financial support of the community. After the songs had been sung through on an Organ of an exceptional value and tone, criticisms which were kind, constructive and encouraging were levelled against Mr. Ajiṣafé which he took with a cheerful heart.

Mr. T. K. E. Phillips first opened the stage with a charming address; he spoke with such frankness that made every member of the audience that night felt that Mr. Phillips is indeed a real lover of native airs and music. He

pointed out some other things which will be to the best interest of Mr. Kolawole Ajiṣafé, amongst which were the superfluity of verses when he compared Mr. Ajiṣafé with Schubert. He advised Mr. Ajiṣafé to take to the study of Theory of Music which he pointed out will assist him very considerably in his endeavours to the composition of native airs and music. Mr. Phillips touched on the advisability of having some additional notes to our present ones. He is not in favour of beating of drums at every turn of singing native songs particularly those for religious services on solemn occasion, other speakers were Mr. J. K. Coker, Bishop Lakew, Mr. C. B. Williams, Mr. E. A. Akintan, Mr. Aina Onabolu who said as a layman, that a composer of native songs who could not evoke the feelings of his hearers for the purpose in which the music is composed lamentably failed in his duties as a composer; also Mrs. Dawodu, Mr. J. G. Kuyé, Miss Janet Olude, Mr. Amosu, Mr. I. J. O. Ṣoyode, and Rev. Bababunmi. The happy gathering came to a close at 11.25 p.m. with Benediction. Three cheers were called up for Mr. Ajiṣafé at the close.
