**"AGBA TI KO BI NU NI QMO R&NPO "****CORRESPONDENCE.****"WEST AFRICA"****The Change of Ownership.**

It was made known in London during the latter part of August that the Weekly Newspaper "West Africa" had changed hands—or rather, changed ownership, for it remains in the same bands, editorial and commercial, in which it has been from its first number, published nearly 15 years ago.

Some time ago an offer was made for the whole of the share capital in the paper (nearly £1,100). It is understood that the offer was made on behalf of the Liverpool and London firm of printers and advertising contractors, which acquired the monthly "West Africa Review", some months ago when Messrs Elder Dempster & Co. ceased to own it. At meetings between the editor of "West Africa", and the shareholders it was made clear that the owners of the majority of the shares felt that as a sale was to take place—a few shareholders wishing to sell the proper course was for the staff itself to buy the entire property, and give an undertaking that the paper should for a period of years be in the hands of its staff alone. The shareholders in turn agreeing not to interest themselves financially for a similar period in any such publication as West Africa in England. This proposal by the staff was accepted by the majority of the staff accepted. A new company was formed, with the same name, and from mid-August the new owners have carried on the business. The paper's name is, of course, unchanged.

The "Times" of August 29 is a reference to the sale states that the senior members of the editorial and business staffs have held their posts since the paper's first publication, and that the paper's editor and founder, Mr. Albert Cartwright, remains in editorial charge and becomes chairman of the company. The "Newspaper World", the old, well-known organ of the British newspaper industry, says that the price paid by the staff was £5,404 share the same figure offered by the outside quarter; and that of this £5,404 per share was in hand, in the shape of accumulated profit, when the staff took over. The "newspaper World" recalls that "Twenty Years Free Street Free Lance", recently remarked of "West Africa" in a volume of reminiscences, that it is known as the "Times of West Africa" and is famous for the courage and independence of its views and the splendid way in which photographs are reproduced. In another English journal it is remarked that "West Africa's" photographic pages have given people in Great Britain quite a new view of the four Coast Colonies.
